

Per the Curia of Their Royal Majesties Donovan Shinnock and Chatricam Meghanta, conducted ethereally in accordance with SCA, Inc. guidelines on 5 February 2026, A.S. 60, the following are enacted into East Kingdom Law.

Kingdom Officers

New IV.A.11. detailing each Kingdom Officer's responsibility to write and maintain documentation of the standard operating procedures, routine tasks, and responsibilities of that officer.

Other East Kingdom Awards

Restructuring Section IX.G. including revisions at the Curia, sorting by scroll-optional and how the Heirs may bestow certain token-bearing awards and recognitions; revised scroll options and bestowal rules for certain awards and recognitions; and corresponding Appendix C updates.

IV. Kingdom Officers

A. Duties and Powers of the Kingdom Officers

11. Kingdom Officers are responsible for maintaining documentation of the standard operating procedures, routine tasks, and responsibilities expected of that officer.
 - a. Upon a change of office, all such documentation will be reviewed by the outgoing and incoming office-holders.
 - b. Each Kingdom Officer will review and update their documentation promptly whenever there is a procedure, task, or responsibility change.
 - c. Each Kingdom Officer is responsible for making their documentation available via the East Kingdom website or the recognized website of their office.

IX. Awards

G. Other East Kingdom Awards

1. ~~These~~ The following awards are not armigerous, ~~and the recipients are not Companions of any Order.~~ These awards may be given by the Heirs in the Crown's name.
 - a. ~~Recipients of these awards are recognized by receiving a token, unless a scroll is explicitly stated for the award.~~
 - b. ~~Recipients of these awards may be recognized by the Crown or the Heirs if so indicated; otherwise, the award is reserved to the Crown.~~
 - a. The Award of the Burdened Tyger
 - i. May be awarded by the Crown to those gentles associated with running an event or an aspect of an event which the Crown feels was well above the normal standard of excellence in the East Kingdom.

- ii. Is not to be presented at the event for which it is being awarded; except at the Pennsic War, during which the Award of the Burdened Tyger may be presented in East Kingdom Court for an exceptional event earlier in the war.
 - iii. As this award is awarded for a specific event, a gentle may receive it any number of times for any number of different events.
- b. The Blue Tyger Legion
- i. May be awarded by the Crown to groups that have demonstrated exceptional martial prowess on the field.
 - ii. During any one reign, no more than one group will be inducted into the Legion.
 - iii. The inducted group is entitled to hang from its banner a schwenkle, bendy purple and or, charged with the initials of the inducting Monarchs.
 - iv. A group may be recognized in this way more than once, in which case the initials of the inducting Crown will be added to the existing schwenkle.
- c. The Award of Valor of the East
- i. May be awarded by the Crown to honor individual members of the armies of the East Kingdom who have distinguished themselves in either of the following ways.
 - 1. By displaying extraordinary command excellence on the battlefield at an Inter-Kingdom War.
 - 2. By displaying extraordinary actions of valor on the battlefield at an Inter-Kingdom War.
 - ii. May be awarded no more than six (6) times during any one reign.
 - iii. The Award of Valor of the East includes all gentles who previously received the King's Order of the Tyger of Valor, the Order of the Valiant Tyger, the Tyger of Valor, and/or the Order of Valor of the East.
- d. The Award of the Golden Lyre
- i. May be awarded to acknowledge any individual or group whose single work or performance, either publicly displayed or exhibited in an Arts & Sciences display at an event attended by the Crown ~~or the Heirs~~, in the Crown's ~~or Heirs'~~ sole opinion and discretion, manifests and represents the fire and passion of the East Kingdom arts.
 - ii. The basis for bestowing this award will rely on the artistic use of period mediums, creativity, and/or inspirational value of the work or performance. The work or performance may be a work in progress. Documentation is not required, but is highly recommended.
 - iii. May be awarded to an individual or group more than once during a reign, but not for the same work or performance.
 - iv. May be awarded by the Sovereign; or Consort, ~~Sovereign's Heir, or Consort's Heir~~ individually, or by the Crown ~~or Heirs~~ acting together.
 - v. A token bearing the badge of the award may be given personally or placed with such meritorious work.
 - vi. The Award of the Golden Lyre includes all gentles who were previously awarded with the Gift of the Golden Lyre and the Gift of the Golden Tyger.
- e. The Company of the Pennon of the East

- i. May be awarded by the Crown to any East Kingdom gentle that has demonstrated exceptional martial prowess on the field, field support, staff, or other gentles who support the East Kingdom at events held in another Kingdom.
 - ii. A Gentle may be inducted into the Company of the Pennon of the East more than once, and no upper or lower limits on the number of gentles to be inducted per reign will be imposed.
 - iii. The token given will be a small pennon or streamer, able to be worn either on the person or attached to a banner, bearing the initials of the awarding Crown. The colors of such token will reflect the host Kingdom of the event for which the award is given.
 - iv. The Company of the Pennon of the East includes all gentles who previously received the Tyger of Foreign Legions.
- f. The Company of Morpheus
 - i. May be given to those who aid in creating a more immersive experience for event attendees through their work in stage dressing, set and lighting design, and photography.
 - ii. May be awarded by the Sovereign; or Consort; ~~Sovereign's Heir, or Consort's Heir~~ individually, or by the Crown ~~or Heirs~~ acting together.
 - iii. Individuals may receive this award more than once, for additional contributions to immersive experience.
 - iv. Recipients of the Company of Morpheus are entitled to receive a token bearing the badge of the award.
- g. The Award of Durga
 - i. May be given to an individual who performs a single extraordinary act of martial prowess, or a superlative accomplishment in any of the martial disciplines.
 - ii. May be awarded by the Sovereign; or Consort; ~~Sovereign's Heir, or Consort's Heir~~ individually, or by the Crown ~~or Heirs~~ acting together.
 - iii. Individuals may receive this award more than once, for additional acts of prowess.
 - iv. The token of the Award of Durga is a tiger's claw.
- h. The Award of Rabbit in the Moon
 - i. May be given to an individual who performs a single extraordinary act of service.
 - ii. May be awarded by the Sovereign; or Consort; ~~Sovereign's Heir, or Consort's Heir~~ individually, or by the Crown ~~or Heirs~~ acting together.
 - iii. Individuals may receive this award more than once, for additional acts of service.
 - iv. Recipients of the Award of Rabbit in the Moon are entitled to receive a token bearing the badge of the award displayed within a circle or on a round field.
- i. The Award of Benzaiten
 - i. May be given to an individual who demonstrates exceptional skill in teaching within the Society.
 - ii. May be bestowed for superlative teaching in any art, science, or service, or in any of the martial disciplines.
 - iii. May be awarded by the Sovereign; or Consort; ~~Sovereign's Heir, or Consort's Heir~~ individually, or by the Crown ~~or Heirs~~ acting together.
 - iv. Individuals may receive this award more than once, for additional acts of teaching.

- v. The token is a ring with a green stone.
 - vi. The Award of Benzaiten includes all gentles who previously received the Award of Anansi's Web.
2. The following awards are not armigerous. Scrolls are optional for these awards, except as otherwise expressly stated.
- a. Augmentation of Arms
 - i. May be awarded by the Crown to honor a person for service to the Kingdom or specifically to the Crown. Each augmentation is specific to the individual awarded, to be added to their arms following consultation with the Brigantia Principal Herald. This honor is infrequently granted.
 - 1. The final decision for the nature of the Augmentation will be determined by the recipient.
 - 2. Should the Crown wish this augmentation be indicative of Them, the Crown has the option to provide the recipient with Permission to Conflict with the registered Personal Arms or Badge of either or both Royalty.
 - 3. Should the Crown wish this augmentation to be indicative of the Kingdom as whole or with a particular Order of the East Kingdom, the Crown has the option to provide the recipient with Permission to Conflict with a designated Augmentation Badge or elements of the Badge of a specific Order.
 - 4. An Augmentation does not grant the permission to augment arms with a charge the recipient is not allowed to bear normally.
 - 5. The Augmentation must follow the rules under the SCA College of Arms' Standards for the Evaluation of Names and Armorial (SENA) A.3.A.3, C.4, and A.6.C.
 - ii. Recipients of this award are entitled to a scroll.
 - iii. All individuals who were previously presented with the Royal Augmentation of Arms or the East Kingdom Augmentation of Arms from prior Royalty from the East Kingdom are considered to have received this award, The Augmentation of Arms.
 - b. The Consort's Cypher
 - i. Is hereby established to recognize those subjects of the East Kingdom who have distinguished themselves by providing exceptional service to the Consort.
 - ii. This may be awarded by the Consort to whomever They deem deserving.
 - iii. The Consort may award no more than ten (10) Consort's Cyphers during any one reign; nor will the Consort feel required to award any at all, if none are clearly meritorious.
 - iv. Recipients will be entitled to either a scroll proclaiming their meritorious services or a personal token of the Consort bearing the Cypher, which is the Consort's initial together with an "R".
 - v. The Consort's Cypher includes all gentles who previously received the Queen's Cypher.
 - c. The Sovereign's Cypher
 - i. Is hereby established to recognize those subjects of the East Kingdom who have distinguished themselves by providing exceptional service to the Sovereign.
 - ii. This may be awarded by the Sovereign to whomever They deem deserving.

- iii. The Sovereign may award no more than ten (10) Sovereign's Cyphers during any one reign; nor will the Sovereign feel required to award any at all, if none are clearly meritorious.
- iv. Recipients will be entitled to either a scroll proclaiming their meritorious services or a personal token of the Sovereign bearing the Cypher, which is the Sovereign's initial together with an "R".
- v. The Sovereign's Cypher includes all gentles who previously received the King's Cypher.
- d. The Consort's Award of Esteem
 - i. May be awarded by the Consort, in order to recognize an act, a series of acts, or general behavior that is not already properly recognized by other East Kingdom awards.
 - ii. The token is not defined, but will be specified in each reign by the Consort and will be fashioned by the Consort's hand.
 - iii. This award will be given solely at the Consort's discretion.
 - iv. A gentle may receive this award more than once, and no upper or lower limits on the number to be awarded per reign will be imposed.
 - v. The Consort's Award of Esteem includes all gentles who previously received the Queen's Honour of Distinction and the Queen's Award of Esteem.
- e. The Sovereign's Award of Esteem
 - i. May be awarded by the Sovereign, to acknowledge special merit in an act, a series of acts, or general behavior that is not already properly recognized by other East Kingdom awards.
 - ii. The token of the Sovereign's Award of Esteem is not defined, but will be specified in each reign by the Sovereign and will be fashioned by the Sovereign's hand.
 - iii. A gentle may receive this award more than once, and no upper or lower limit on the number to be awarded per reign will be imposed.
 - iv. The Sovereign's Award of Esteem includes all gentles who previously received the King's Esteem of Merit and the King's Award of Esteem.
- f. The Company of Fellowship
 - i. May be awarded by the Crown to a recognized branch within the East Kingdom, below the kingdom or principality level, which displays an exceptional level of unity while promoting the ideals of the Kingdom and the Society.
 - ii. During any one reign, no more than one group will be awarded the Company of Fellowship.
 - iii. Is not to be presented at the event for which it is being awarded; except at the Pennsic War, during which it may be presented in East Kingdom Court for an exceptional event earlier in the war.
 - iv. As this award is for a specific event, a group may receive it any number of times for any number of different events.
 - v. Recipients are entitled to fly a pennon in conjunction with their branch arms bearing the badge of the Company of Fellowship and the initials of the bestowing Crown.
