 - e. All entrants and consorts must be at least eighteen years of age of legal age of majority for all East Kingdom territories.

 <u>d.</u> Supervises the Lesser Office of Royal Awards Scheduler
- C. Lesser Officers and Their Individual Duties
 - 15. The Royal Awards Scheduler
 - a. Schedules awards given by the Crown by coordinating with the reign staff and the office of the Tyger Clerk of the Signet.
 - b. Works with the Eastern Crown Herald in their areas of mutual interest.
 - c. Is responsible to the Tyger Clerk of the Signet.

VII. Branches

- G. Baronies
 - 6. Appointment and Investiture of Territorial Barons/Baronesses
 - e. A candidate for any Baronial Seat must:
 - i. Be at least eighteen years of age of legal age of majority within the formally approved boundaries of the branch.

The Pennsic War

1. The East Kingdom is responsible for choosing the autocrat for Pennsic Wars to be held every third year beginning at Pennsic 48-(2019).

IX. Awards

- D. Orders of High Merit
 - 4. The Order of the Tygers Combattant (established October 9 A.S. 11, 1976, by Laeghaire and Ysabeau II; revised May 31 A.S. 50, 2015, by Darius V, called Omega, and Etheldreda IV<u>: revised July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi</u>) may be given to individuals who have distinguished themselves by prowess in armored combat,

whether by attaining a standard of excellence such as makes them noteworthy in the eyes of the Kingdom or by attempting more than one weapons form and, while not attaining mastery in any one, surpassing competence in several: and through demonstrated service to the armored combat community, such as by marshaling, teaching, or promoting and expanding the knowledge of armored combat.

- 6. The Order of the Golden Rapier (established April 26 A.S. 26, 1992, by Ruslan and Margaret: revised July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi) may be given to individuals who have distinguished themselves by excellence in the art of rapier arts by consistently demonstrating superior prowess; in the lists, and through demonstrated service to the rapier community, such as by marshaling, by teaching, or by helping to promote and expand promoting and expanding the knowledge of their rapier arts.
- G. Other East Kingdom Awards
 - The Award of the Burdened Tyger (established February 14 A.S. 10, 1976, by Aonghais II and Ysabeau; renamed January 26 A.S. 48, 2014, by Kenric II and Avelina II; revised May 31 A.S. 50, 2015, by Darius V, called Omega, and Etheldreda IV; revised July 9 A.S. 51, 2016, by Kenric III and Avelina III<u>; revised July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi</u>)
 - a. The Award of the Burdened Tyger may be awarded by the Crown to those gentles associated with running an event or an aspect of an event which the Crown attended, and which They-feels was well above the normal standard of excellence in the East Kingdom.

 - a. <u>The Company of Morpheus may be given to those who aid in creating a more</u> <u>immersive experience for event attendees through their work in stage dressing, set</u> <u>and lighting design, and photography.</u>
 - b. <u>The Company of Morpheus may be awarded by the Sovereign or Consort</u> individually, or by the Crown acting together.
 - c. <u>Individuals may receive this token more than once, for additional contributions to</u> <u>immersive experience.</u>
 - d. <u>The badge of the Company of Morpheus is: (Fieldless) A pile of sand Or.</u>
 - 14. The Award of Durga (established July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi)
 - a. <u>The Award of Durga may be given to an individual who performs a single</u> <u>extraordinary act of martial prowess, or a superlative accomplishment in any of the</u> <u>martial disciplines.</u>
 - b. <u>The Award of Durga may be awarded by the Sovereign or Consort individually, or by</u> <u>the Crown acting together.</u>
 - c. Individuals may receive this token more than once, for additional acts of prowess.
 - d. The token of the Award of Durga is: a Tyger's claw (placeholder token).

- 15. The Award of the Rabbit and Moon (established July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi)
 - a. <u>The Award of the Rabbit and Moon may be given to an individual who performs a single extraordinary act of service.</u>
 - b. <u>The Award of the Rabbit and Moon may be awarded by the Sovereign or Consort</u> <u>individually, or by the Crown acting together.</u>
 - c. Individuals may receive this token more than once, for additional acts of service.
 - d. <u>The badge of the Award of the Rabbit and Moon is: Argent, a rabbit sejant erect and a bordure vert. This badge should always be displayed on a round field, so that it looks like the Japanese folk tale of the rabbit in the moon.</u>
- <u>16. The Award of Anansi's Web (placeholder name)</u> (established July 17 A.S. 57, 2022, by Ryouko'jin and Indrakshi)
 - a. <u>The Award of Anansi's Web may be given to an individual who demonstrates</u> exceptional skill in teaching within the Society.
 - b. <u>The Award of Anansi's Web may be bestowed for superlative teaching in any art</u>, <u>science, or service, or in any of the martial disciplines.</u>
 - c. <u>The Award of Anansi's Web may be awarded by the Sovereign or Consort</u> <u>individually, or by the Crown acting together.</u>
 - d. Individuals may receive this token more than once, for additional acts of teaching.
 - e. The token of the Award of Anansi's Web is: a spider's web (placeholder token).
