c. Trains unit leaders and battle commanders for the war campaigns of the East Kingdom, and others interested in the skills of leadership.

d. Assists with the implementation of Kingdom-wide war-related strategy and tactics.

e. Encourages education in strategy and tactics among the warriors of the armies of the East Kingdom.

f. Is responsible to the Earl Marshal.

C. Polling Procedures

2. Ballots and the Polling Process

f. The Royals are not bound to act in accordance with the numerical outcome of any polling. In the event of a Baronial Seat polling, the Royals must make Their selection from one of the choices presented on the ballot for the polling They are deciding. For pollings in which a single-choice ballot template is used, the outcome of the polling will be determined by a simple majority of valid returned ballots. If a polling fails to result in such a simple majority, the disposition of the polling falls to The Crown.
